Across The Federation of Hackbridge Primary School and Spencer Nursery School, we pride ourselves in looking smart by wearing our school uniform, which follows the Uniform policy. Wearing uniform promotes a sense of community within the school and allows children to demonstrate their pride in their school, both within school and when they are out in the local community.

Clothing guidelines are also enclosed for children attending our 0-3 provision at Spencer Nursery School.

## **Information for all pupils across the federation:**

- **Please ensure that your child brings a coat to school every day, even in good weather.**
- Long hair must be tied back at all times.
- Pupils with pierced ears may wear ONE single or pair of small, simple stud earrings in their STANDARD LOBE ONLY. Hoop earrings and keeper earrings are not allowed at school for health and safety reasons. Piercings in any other part of the ear or elsewhere on the body are not allowed.

Pupils MUST NOT wear earrings to school on PE days or must be able to remove their earrings by themselves so that they can take part in PE lessons.

Pupils in Reception to Year 6 who are planning to have their ears pierced should do so in the first week of the summer holidays in order that they can heal before they return to school.

- No other jewellery is allowed. This includes teething necklaces/bracelets/anklets.
- Tattoos, transfers and nail polish must not be worn in school.
- Simple wrist watches or fitness trackers are permitted from Year 3, but are bought to school at pupils' own risk. They must be silent and named. They must not be able to record sound or video images or send/receive messages.
- Members from the Muslim community who choose to wear a head covering garment should wear a plain short black or royal blue hijab. If wearing summer uniform, this should be a plain white short white hijab.
- Members from the Sikh community who wear a patka or turban should wear one in a plain black, blue or white (school uniform colours).

## **Other Information:**

- Children from Reception to Year 6 at Hackbridge Primary School are encouraged to bring a clear, named, bottle of water to school each day, CONTAINING WATER ONLY, which they can drink in their classroom during lesson times. School water bottles are available from the School Office. (Children in the Nursery classes at both schools do not need a water bottle as they have access to a water station throughout their session/day.)

**ALL ARTICLES MUST BE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S FULL NAME.  
THE SCHOOL CANNOT ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOST ITEMS.**

**If anybody has difficulty complying with the Uniform policy on ethical or medical grounds this should be referred to the Headteacher.**

## Nursery

### **Hackbridge Primary School**

#### **Caterpillars, Honeybees & Tadpoles classes**

- A blue round-neck sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo. *These are available for purchase online from Schoolwear Inc. via the school website or directly from their storeroom at 198 – 202 Cheam Common Road, Worcester Park, Surrey, KT4 8QJ.*
- A plain white polo-shirt.
- Any dark colour trousers, jogging bottoms or leggings.
- In the summer, dark colour shorts may be worn.
- Book Bag. *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc.*
- A small drawstring bag for spare clothes. *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc.*

### **Spencer Nursery School**

#### **Ladybirds and Bumblebees classes**

- Inexpensive clothing which is appropriate for the wide range of indoor and outdoor activities that are a part of the daily Nursery experience. Leggings/Jogging bottoms, t-shirts and sweatshirts are ideal.

#### **Fireflies class**

- A red round-neck sweatshirt with the school logo. *These are available for purchase from Spencer Nursery School Office.*
- A plain white polo-shirt.
- Any dark colour trousers, jogging bottoms or leggings.
- In the summer, dark colour shorts may be worn.
- Book Bag. *These are available for purchase from Spencer Nursery School Office.*
- A small drawstring bag for spare clothes. *These are available for purchase from Spencer Nursery School Office.*

### **All Nursery Classes**

Due to the prominence of physical development activities within the EYFS curriculum, pupils attending Nursery are required to wear plimsolls or trainers and trouser bottoms and not skirts/dresses for dignity and health & safety reasons.

Please note that **mules, sandals, sling backs, peep toes, long boots or fashion shoes** are not permitted.

In consideration for members of our community who suffer with epilepsy, children are not permitted to wear shoes with flashing lights.

## Reception

### Hackbridge Primary School

#### Badgers, Hedgehogs, Moles and Squirrels classes

- A blue round-neck sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo. *These are available for purchase online from Schoolwear Inc. via the school website or directly from their storeroom at 198 – 202 Cheam Common Road, Worcester Park, Surrey, KT4 8QJ.*
- A plain white polo-shirt. *Optional polo-shirts with the school logo are available from Schoolwear Inc.*
- Plain black jogging bottoms.
- In the summer, grey trouser style shorts (not sports shorts) or a light blue **check** dress may be worn. Please note that playsuits are not permitted and that tights must not be worn underneath shorts.
- White, grey or black socks or tights.
- Black plimsolls or black trainers (no coloured logos).
- Book Bag. *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc.*

Due to the prominence of physical development activities within the EYFS curriculum, pupils attending Reception are required to wear plimsolls or trainers and trouser bottoms and not skirts/dresses for dignity and health & safety reasons.

Please note that **mules, sandals, sling backs, peep toes, long boots or fashion shoes** are not permitted.

In consideration for members of our community who suffer with epilepsy, children are not permitted to wear shoes with flashing lights.

#### PE Kit for Reception (worn to school on PE days; not kept in school)

- A plain white, round-neck t-shirt – not the polo-shirt worn for school. *Optional PE t-shirts with the school logo are available from Schoolwear Inc.*
- Blue 'shadow stripe' shorts. *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc. Please note that tights cannot be worn underneath shorts.*
- Plain navy jogging bottoms and sweatshirt – to be worn in the winter for outdoor games.
- Black plimsolls – for games (children are barefoot for gymnastics and dance lessons).
- NO JEWELLERY, including earrings, or tights may be worn for PE.

## Years 1 and 2

### Hackbridge Primary School

#### Dolphins, Seals, Sea Otters, Turtles, Leopards, Panthers, Lions and Tigers classes

- A blue round-neck sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo. *These are available for purchase online from Schoolwear Inc. via the school website or directly from their storeroom at 198 – 202 Cheam Common Road, Worcester Park, Surrey, KT4 8QJ.*
- A plain white polo-shirt. *Optional polo-shirts with the school logo are available from Schoolwear Inc.*
- For Years 1 to 6: A grey skirt, pinafore dress or trousers.  
Please note that trousers **MUST BE GREY SCHOOL TROUSERS and not leggings, jeggings, combats, jeans, jogging bottoms or fashion trousers, i.e. 'skinny fit' or 'bootleg' or playsuits. No leggings or cycling shorts are to be worn under skirts/dresses.**
- In the summer, grey trouser style shorts (not sports shorts) or a light blue **check** dress may be worn.  
Please note that playsuits are not permitted and that tights must not be worn underneath shorts.
- White, grey or black socks or tights.
- Sensible, flat black school shoes must be worn.  
Please note that children are **NOT permitted to wear trainers, mules, sandals, sling backs, peep toes, boots or fashion shoes.** In consideration for members of our community who suffer with epilepsy, children are not permitted to wear shoes with flashing lights.
- Book Bag. *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc.*

#### PE Kit for Years 1 and 2 (worn to school on PE days; not kept in school)

- A plain white, round-neck t-shirt – not the polo-shirt worn for school. *Optional PE t-shirts with the school logo are available from Schoolwear Inc.*
- Blue 'shadow stripe' shorts. *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc. Please note that tights cannot be worn underneath shorts.*
- Plain navy jogging bottoms and sweatshirt – to be worn in the winter for outdoor games.
- Black plimsolls – for games (children are barefoot for gymnastics and dance lessons).
- Trainers for 'The Daily Mile' (optional).
- NO JEWELLERY, including earrings, or tights may be worn for PE.

## Years 3 to 6

### Hackbridge Primary School

#### Flamingos, Peacocks, Toucans, Lemurs, Meerkats, Raccoons, Orcas, Penguins, Polar Bears, Elephants, Giraffes and Rhinos classes

- A blue V-neck sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo. *These are available for purchase online from Schoolwear Inc. via the school website or directly from their storeroom at 198 – 202 Cheam Common Road, Worcester Park, Surrey, KT4 8QJ.*
- Hackbridge Primary School tie (*elasticated ties will be available to purchase for pupils in Years 3 & 4 and a traditional tie for pupils in Years 5 & 6*). *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc.*
- A plain collared white button up shirt (long or short sleeve shirts may be worn).
- A grey skirt, pinafore dress or trousers.  
Please note that trousers **MUST BE GREY SCHOOL TROUSERS and not leggings, jeggings, combats, jeans, jogging bottoms or fashion trousers, i.e. 'skinny fit' or 'bootleg' or playsuits. No leggings or cycling shorts are to be worn under skirts/dresses.**
- In the summer, grey trouser style shorts (not sports shorts) or a light blue **check** dress may be worn. Please note that playsuits are not permitted and that shorts may not be worn with tights.
- White, grey or black socks or tights.
- Sensible, flat black school shoes must be worn.  
Please note that children are **NOT permitted to wear trainers, mules, sandals, sling backs, peep toes, boots or fashion shoes.** In consideration for members of our community who suffer with epilepsy, children are not permitted to wear shoes with flashing lights.
- Backpack (no bigger than 35cm tall × 25cm wide × 9cm deep due to space for storage).

#### PE Kit for Years 3 to 6 (worn to school on PE days; not kept in school)

- A plain white, round-neck t-shirt – not the polo-shirt worn for school. *Optional PE t-shirts with the school logo are available from Schoolwear Inc.*
- Blue 'shadow stripe' shorts. *These are available for purchase from Schoolwear Inc. Please note that tights cannot be worn underneath shorts.*
- Plain navy jogging bottoms and sweatshirt – to be worn in the winter for outdoor games.
- Black plimsolls – for games (children are barefoot for gymnastics and dance lessons).
- Trainers for 'The Daily Mile' (optional).
- NO JEWELLERY, including earrings, or tights may be worn for PE.
