What do we need to do this year?

This is a quick guide to some of the things we will be concentrating on over the next school year to make the school even better.

Literacy Leader: Miss O'Doherty

- Promote a love of reading and develop use of Bug Club books online and continue to signpost families to reading resources.
- Continue to raise the profile and use of Spelling Shed and PiXL Vocabulary App.
- Children to know and use the different lenses of writing from the Writing Rainbow.
- Further develop the teaching and learning in Phonics across the key stages.

Maths Leader: Mr Jasper

- Ensure challenge for all learners in all lessons.
- Engage parents with workshops on calculations.
- Promote Times Table Rock Stars and Sumdog.
- Promote mathematical fluency with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division facts.
- Ensure children can explain their learning.
- Develop consistency of vocabulary across the school.

Computing Leader: Mrs Ruparelia

- Ensure children are confident using a range of devices, including iPads, Chrome books, PCs.
- Ensure they use these devices safely.
- Become more confident in using programs in school.
- Ensure children have a healthy computing curriculum using a range of devices and programmes.
- Ensure the secure use of G-Suite for education in KS2.
- Introduce the use of Google Classroom for home learning.

Behaviour and Safety Leaders: Miss Adnyana and Mrs Edmonds-Chappell

- Ensure the children know how to keep themselves safe both in school and outside within the context of our school rules.
- Ensure the children know how to keep safe online.
- Parents to receive regular updates from National Online Safety organisation.

Health and wellbeing Leader: Miss Adnyana

- Provide children with opportunities to explore and express feelings and emotions during circle times and PSHE lessons.
- Teach children how to lead healthy and active lifestyles.
- Teach children about mental wellbeing and how to seek support if they need it.
- Develop representation of our diverse community within the school curriculum.

PE and Sports Leaders: Mr Coppin

- Ensure children are engaged in regular exercise.
- Increase participation in sports clubs across the school when we are allowed to.
- Take part in a range of inter borough competitions and sporting events when they start up again.
- Increase the percentage of active lessons during the school day.

- Ensure all subject areas provide challenge for all learners.
- Use Cornerstones topics to plan exciting, relevant and meaningful learning opportunities.
